



The ECAC is an 80-year old intercollegiate athletics conference, comprised of over 200 member schools from Maine to George and west to Missouri, but primarily in the Northeast. The Conference spans NCAA Divisions I, II, and III. ECAC conducts leagues, tournaments, bowl games and other competitions, with the primary function of putting on top-tier championships in all three divisions.

The 80-plus Division I members participate in cross country, indoor and outdoor track and field, and swimming championships. At the Division II and Division III level, championships are held in a broad spectrum of sports. Additionally, the ECAC has been among the first intercollegiate conferences to sponsor Esports, and it presently has twenty schools participating in ECAC Esports across five different gaming platforms. This year, ECAC will also sponsor a championship in rugby.

The ECAC publicizes the achievements of thousands of student-athletes annually through its monthly and post-season awards, and annually recognizes institutions, administrators, student-athletes, and officials for yearly and career achievements.

The prestigious Asa S. Bushnell internship program, named after the first commissioner of the ECAC and established in 1976, offers hands-on experience in all areas of the only multi-divisional conference in the country. Former interns proudly represent the ECAC in all fields of the sports industry as directors of athletics, commissioners, broadcasting executives, professional franchise front-office executives, sports information directors and coaches.
